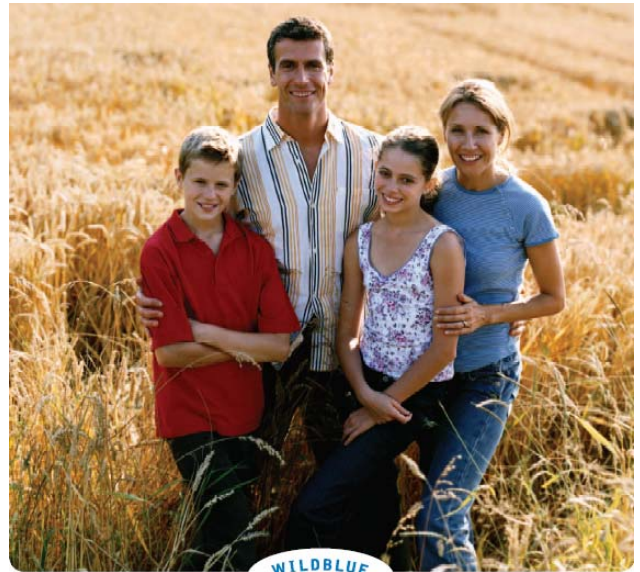

Reminder...if you qualify for the Low Income Telephone Assistance Program (LITAP) you must provide us with one of the following:

- A copy of your LIHEAP (Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program Eligibility)
- A copy of your Medicaid documentation
- Letter from the Human Services Dept.
- Proof of Income

New Mexico state law requires everyone involved in any excavation to provide at least two working days notice to owners of underground facilities when a dig is planned. *Whether you are digging a few inches or several feet the law requires you to call before you dig.* For more information visit the New Mexico One Call website at www.nmonecall.org.

"Ice" your Cell Phone?

You may have recently received an email telling you to "ICE" your cellular phone book and wondered if the message was just another hoax. Actually, it's a campaign to encourage people to store emergency contact details in their mobile phones.

Bob Brotchie, a British paramedic, came up with the idea after struggling to get contact details from injured patients.

You can help emergency workers by entering, in your cellular contact list, **ICE** (for In Case of Emergency) before the name of people you'd like called. You can have more than one ICE number and can designate a call order such as ICE1 - Bob Smith, ICE2 - Sue Smith, etc.

Make sure your ICE contacts know about medical conditions that could affect your treatment - for example allergies or current medication. Provide your ICE partner with a list of people they should contact on your behalf. If the cell phone owner is under 18, one of the ICE contacts should be a parent or legal guardian who is authorized to make decisions on their behalf.

"ICE" is not intended to replace traditional forms of identification and medical alerts. However, these entries can be very helpful when used in conjunction with other types of identification.
